Reading Challenge- Year 5

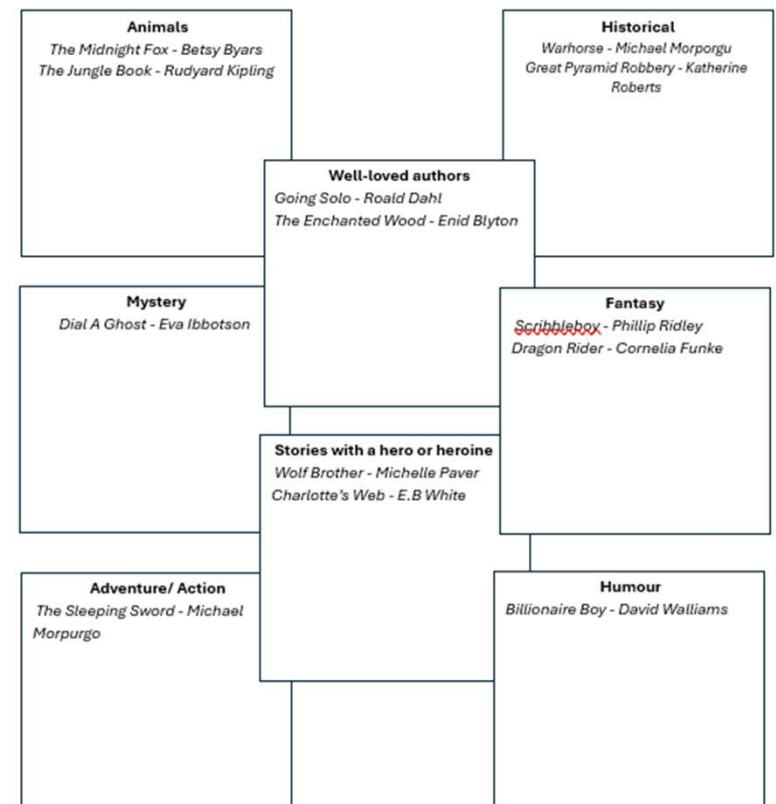


During this school year, we challenge you to broaden your reading!

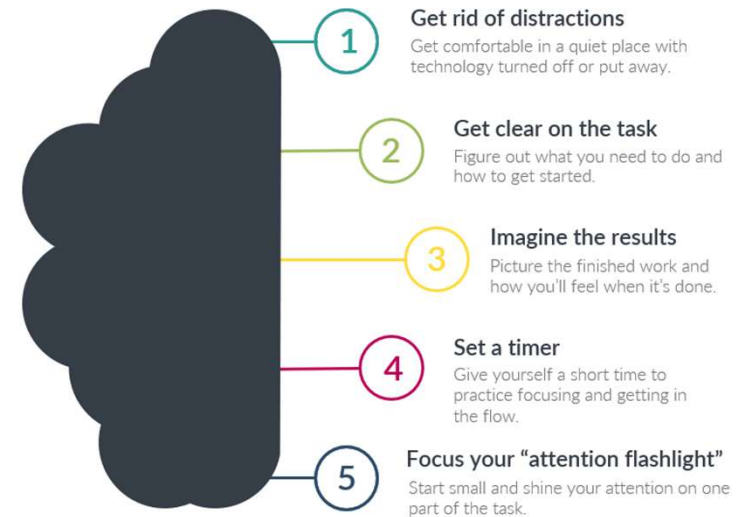
Spellings
